Have a great weekend - we are hoping for some sun!

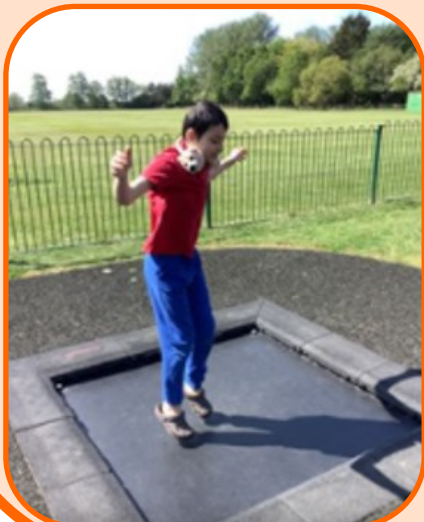
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Cobra Class

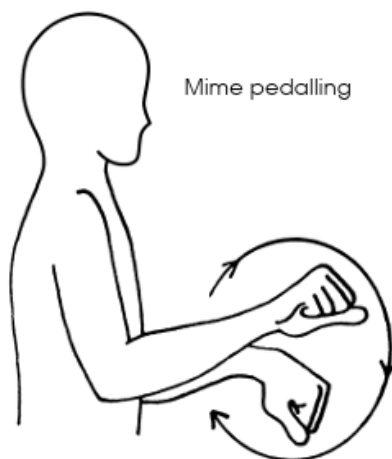

We also made our own sand art.



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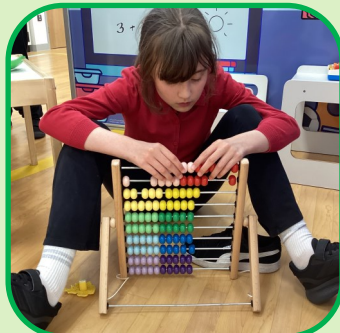
Peacock Class
